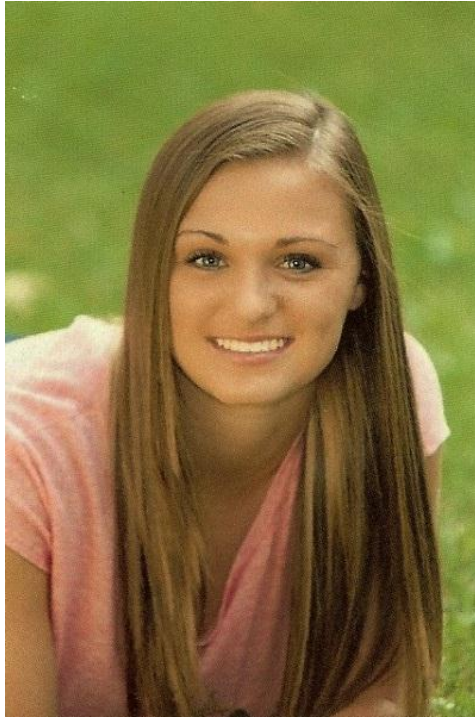


IA-IL Chapter \$2000 STEM SCHOLARSHIP WINNER
