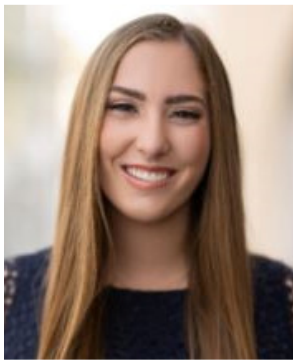




## IOWA/ILLINOIS NDIA CHAPTER
